6)	Does the employer train affected employees to perform assigned rescue duties?	1910.146(k)(2)(ii)			
7)	Does the employer train employees who will perform rescue in basic first aid and cardiopulmonary resuscitation (CPR)?	1910.146(k)(2)(iii)
